Front Office – answer phones in the front office one day a week

Front Office Computer Input – inputting attendance

Book Nook – organize and maintain for 1-2 hours per month

Bus Driver – drive for events

BUILDING AND GROUNDS

Building Care/Maintenance – assist with minor repair and upkeep, such as plumbing, light bulbs, painting, etc.

Grounds Care/Maintenance – assist with the upkeep and beautification for the grounds, such as pressure washing, tree trimming, etc.

COMMUNICATIONS MINISTRY

Photographer/Videographer – photograph/video church events on an as-needed basis

Social Media Ambassador – engage with church posts, and share events, videos, etc. on your own social media periodically to raise awareness and tell the church's story

Live Stream – assist with cameras, sound, slides, and more (training provided)

CONGREGATIONAL CARE

Homebound Communion – deliver to homebound or nursing home members once a month

Make Phone Calls – call homebound members once a month

Visit Hospitals – visit members in hospital once a month

We Care – prepare a dish for a funeral meal as needed

Visit Homebound/Nursing Homes – visit members who are homebound or in nursing homes once a month

Baked Blessings Baker/Deliverer – bake and/or deliver casseroles for those with new babies, those released from hospital, or who are sick Flower Ministry Arranger/Deliverer – arrange altar flowers into smaller vases and/or deliver those arrangements to homes on Mondays

FOOD SERVICE MINISTRY

Hospitality/Special Events - serve as a greeter, and assist in setting up and breaking down after events

Wednesday Night Supper – assist in serving the meal, or serve as a cashier, once a month

Street Worship - assist with setup/breakdown, and prayer teams, each Monday, 4:00-7:00pm

Lighthouses – share love of Christ and bring goods and provisions to areas of Dothan, Tuesdays, 9:00-11:30am and 2:00-4:30pm

Children's Ministry – Wednesdays and Saturdays 5:00-7:30pm

Discipleship Mentor – develop one-on-one spiritual and life mentoring, one hour per week, based on mentor's schedule

Bible Study and Breakfast – serve breakfast and participate in Bible study and prayer, Wednesdays, 7:00-8:00am Wednesday Serving Day - prepare and sort clothing, hygiene, food pantry, etc., Wednesdays, 8:00-10:30am

Provide and Serve Meals – families, groups or individuals serve/minister on Saturday mornings and evenings, and Wednesday evenings

Worship – participate in worship, prayer teams, and serving the meal, Wednesday and Saturday, 5:00-7:30pm

Saturday Morning Community Day – assist with clothing, hygiene, groceries, showers, laundry, prayer teams, children teams, garden teams, and serving meal, Saturdays, 7:30-10:30am

Street Ministry - Wednesdays and Saturdays, 8:30-10:30am

Grow Hope Farm at The Harbor – gardening, harvesting, planting, and other care needs weekly

Transportation Team – Wednesdays and Saturdays, 4:00-7:30pm

Intercessory Prayer Teams – pray from home or at The Harbor different times of the week

Case Work – Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, 12:00-4:00pm and Saturdays, 8:00am-12:00noon (training provided)

Shower Ministry – utilizing the shower trailer and taking to different areas of the city

Bible Study/Small Group Leader – lead and facilitate small groups in relationship and spiritual growth

HOSPITALITY

Usher – assist in seating, receive offering during worship

Greeter – welcome guests to worship

Parking Lot Greeter – greet guests in parking areas

First Step Connector – partner with newcomers to assimilate

Hospitality Center Host or Hostess – welcome and facilitate conversations in the Hospitality Center

Member Follow-Up Team – reach out by phone to members absent for long periods

New Member Breakfast – prepare food, host table groups, and greet new members

MISSIONS MINISTRY

Adopt-A-School – help with our adopted school (Head Start)

Blood Donor – donate at least twice a year at blood drives

Church Party – serve with special needs children on Tuesdays evenings during the school year, or drive bus

In Christ's Name – join team that interviews and helps people in need on Monday mornings

Meals on Wheels – deliver meals to elderly once a week

Mission Trip – go on cross-cultural mission trip to provide medical assistance, evangelism, prayer, or other support
