Building Care/Maintenance – assist with minor repair and upkeep, such as plumbing, light bulbs, painting, etc.

Prayer Shawls/Blankets – knit, quilt, or crochet prayer shawls/blankets at home (instructors available)

Visit Hospitals – visit members in hospital once a month

Visit Homebound/Nursing Homes – visit members who are homebound or in nursing homes once a month

We Care – prepare a dish for a funeral meal as needed

FOOD SERVICE MINISTRY

Hospitality/Special Events – serve as a greeter, and assist in setting up and breaking down after events

Wednesday Night Supper – assist in serving the meal, or serve as a cashier, once a month

Class/Program Instructor – begin and lead a class or activity
