It all started with an invitation.

The experience of grace, is vast in the same way the ocean is vast. The ocean is deep and wide enough to make up most of the world's surface. It's a place we visit, admire, and enjoy, but we only ever get to see a small portion of it at a time. That was so meaningful to me. We worshiped together for that hour, and I just soaked it in.

After attending for several months, the church was getting ready for summer and Vacation Bible School. I had heard every announcement, read them on the back of the bulletin, saw the postings and requests for volunteers, and never once made the connection that they were inviting me to take part in anything. Then, one day, I received a call from Mrs. Linda who was the "church lady" who helped with everything. She called to invite me to lead the music for VBS, but I perceived her invitation as a desperate plea for help. After convincing me I didn't need to be "good" at music, and even though I was

quite full of self-doubt, I decided I would give it a shot. Mrs. Linda was thrilled.

This one invitation turned out to be a life-changing event for me. From there I went on to help several churches in our community with VBS music that summer and even the next.

This small portion of my journey eventually led to discerning my call to ministry. With this one simple invitation, God has worked repeatedly, and I have had a glimpse into the beautiful kingdom of God.

In John 1:43-51, there are two invitations, Philip is invited to follow Jesus, and later, Phillip invites Nathanael to meet Jesus. As Nathanael encounters Jesus, his eyes are opened more and more to the wonders of God. Jesus called Nathanael to see and experience the great power of God in the transformation of discipleship. This is the cresting wave of grace that took Nathanael even deeper into the life of faith. More than an invitation to believe, he had been invited to be a part of the faithful.

Likewise, God's grace is at work in your life right now, even if you don't realize it. God is reaching out to you, calling you into the journey of discipleship. Maybe in an audible way like Philip, through other means like Ms. Linda, or through a friend like Nathanael. I hope you won't ignore the nudges and invitations.
